LOCATION & FACILITIES

The club facilities consist of a clubhouse, 150-yard rifle range, 25-yard pistol range, trap range, 5-stand sporting clays, and a small archery range.

DIRECTIONS

From Wilmington: Route 100 South approximately 4.5 miles to Fowler Road. Right turn onto Fowler Road for approximately .5 miles. Clubhouse is on the right side of the road.

From Jacksonville: Route 100 North to Fowler Road on Left. Then same as above.
